Introduction of Extra-curricular activities (ECAs) and Enrollment Form (S.5)

A) Aim

1. Build up the students' confidence, nurture their sense of responsibility and sportsmanship.
2. Raise students' awareness of being a civilized person and develop better self-discipline.
3. Provide training related to performing arts and inspire their multi-intelligences.

B) Principles

1. According to the Education Bureau, extra-curricular activities refer to the activities taken place out of the daily teaching in class that relate to learning. Therefore, it is a part of the school curriculum. All S.5 students can choose not more than 2 ECAs.
2. A grade of the students' performance in ECA will be given on the students' report cards at the end of the school year.

C) Enrollment

1. Please read the introduction of our school ECAs and prioritise your child's choices. Please ask your child to submit the enrollment form to the class teacher by 19 September (Monday). Late submissions will be dealt with at the least priority. The result will be released on 21 September (Wednesday).
2. A screening of the school sport teams took place from 5 to 9 September. Students should contact their PE teachers if they still want to join the team.
3. Great emphasis is placed on students' discipline and obedience in uniform teams. As a consequence, students can only serve in 1 uniform team and no changes are allowed.
4. In order to encourage continuous learning, all ECAs are held throughout the year. Students should think carefully when deciding on the appropriate ECAs. They are not allowed to drop out of their ECA once they are enrolled, unless the medical proof is given.
5. Students have to pay the full fees, if necessary.
6. Parents can apply for "The Hong Kong Jockey Club Life-wide Learning Fund" (if necessary) and students will be subsidised.

D) Attendance

1. Students should attend their ECA on time. Students can be absent from the meeting of the ECA if a parent letter is submitted to the related teacher 2 days in advance of the meeting. We do not accept regular leave. A record of absence will be made if students do not meet the attendance requirement.
2. A record of absence will be made if students are late for 15 minutes for no reason.
3. Parents will be notified by our staff if students are absent from the ECA for no reason. A warning letter will be issued if students are absent from the ECA for four times. A demerit will be given for every 5 absence.
