- If any student requests to withdraw before departure, the withdrawing student must pay additional fees incurred due to withdrawal from the tour. The Education Bureau may withdraw their sponsorship for the student, and the student will be required to pay the related tour fees and additional withdrawal fees (total of HKD \$1,600). Only in special circumstances, will the Education Bureau consider not withdrawing their sponsorship for that student. If students are unable to participate in mainland visits, the school needs to report to the Education Bureau for follow-up.
- The study tour is covered by basic group comprehensive travel insurance purchased by the Education Bureau. If necessary, parents can purchase additional travel insurance for their children.
- Students must follow the teachers' instructions, strictly abide by the rules and regulations, and pay attention to safety. If you encounter any accidents or special circumstances, you must report to the teachers immediately.

Students are required to complete relevant learning activities before, during, and after the study tour. After the mainland study tour, students will need to engage in a learning project and submit a report in the form of individual assignment to the school. The learning project will not involve public assessment, but the school will reflect in the school report card and the Student Learning Profile (SLP) during the mainland study tour and their performance in the learning project.

According to Circular No. 73/2023 issued by the Education Bureau on 18 May 2023, to showcase students' learning outcomes, the Education Bureau will collect students' work related to the mainland study tour (including photos, videos, student reflections, etc.) from schools. The Education Bureau will integrate and showcase student learning outcomes in diverse ways, including setting up dedicated web pages, organizing touring exhibitions, or inter-school activities for educational and promotional purposes. If students or parents/guardians do not agree to authorize the Education Bureau to use, modify, or publicly disclose all or part of students' work for educational and promotional purposes, please contact the CSD subject teacher at our school.

This study tour is an important component of the CSD curriculum, aiming to enhance students' understanding of the national situation, the latest developments in the country, and to foster appreciation and knowledge of Chinese culture. It is crucial for parents to encourage their children to actively seize the learning opportunities presented and attend all activities punctually.
