Announcement of Results

: Lists of the prize winners and winning entries will be uploaded to the above websites by mid-May 2019. Winners and their schools will be notified by post.

Prize-winning E-Cards

: The winning entries will be shared by other parents and students, who may send the e-cards to their teachers to show their respect.

General Regulations

- 7. Awardees must collect the certificate and prize before 31 August 2019. Uncollected certificates and prizes will be deregistered thereafter. The Organisers are not obliged to reissue replacement certificates and prizes.
